بعض الحجاج يلبون بصوت جامعي، فيتقدم واحد منهم أو يكون في الوسط أو في الخلف ويؤدي ثم يتبعونه بصوت واحد، وهذا لم يرد عن الصحابة رضي الله عنهم، بل قال أنس بن مالك: كنا مع النبي ﷺ - يعني في حجة الوداع - فمنا المكبر، ومنا المهلل، ومنا الملبّي، وهذا هو المشروع للمسلمين، أن يؤدي كل واحد بنفسه، وألا يكون تعلق بغيره.

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## The Talbiyyah in Unison

His Eminence, Shaikh Muhammad Bin Saalih Al-'Uthaymeen said:

Some pilgrims on Hajj make the *talbiyyah* (*labbaik allahumma labbaik ...*) in unison. So one of them goes to the front, or is in the middle, or the back, and says the *talbiyyah*, then they follow him with one voice in unison. This has not been reported from the Companions (*radiyallaahu 'anhum*). Rather, Anas Ibn Maalik (*radiyallaahu 'anhu*) said: **“We were with the Prophet ﷺ, meaning in the farewell hajj, and so from us was one who would say ‘Allaahu Akbar’, and from us was one who would say ‘Laa ilaaha illal-Ilaah’, and from us was one who would say ‘labbaik allahumma labbaik...’”** This is what is legislated for the Muslims, that every individual says the *talbiyyah* by himself and that he doesn't have in that any connection with others.
